



OTST 2024 Guide for local transportation in Marburg

Welcome to Marburg! This is a practical guide for our delegates to move around the University City of Marburg.



Important: Marburg is a small city, if you are staying close to the centre, it is very unlikely that you will need to use transportation daily. All the events of the conference happen within walking distance and are connected by pedestrian streets.

However, if you do require it, the bus services are well organized.

You can buy single tickets, day passes (Tageskarte) or week passes (Wochenkarte) when entering any bus, in addition if you purchased the "49€-train-ticket", this entitles you to use the buses as well.



The bus stop named Rudolfsplatz served by many bus lines is the closest to both:
The Physics Department [Renhof 5], where the technical program will take place.
And the Alte Aula (or Alte Universität) [Reitgasse 2] where the welcome reception will be

The Castle has its own stop named Schloss served by line 10 only, this is where the conference banquet will be hosted.
