



Guide to walking between venues

The map at the end of this document should help you to find the three locations where the conference will take place. Marburg is a small town and you can reach everything on foot. From the Welcome Hotel (where some of you will certainly be staying) to the physics department is only about a 5 minute walk. Right in front of the Welcome Hotel there is an elevator to the upper town (marked by the red star). When you leave the elevator, you have to walk through a short corridor. Then turn right up the hill to the physics department.

In general, if you have a hotel in the city center, you can reach everything walking and do not need public transport.

Conference Site

The conference will mainly take place in the large lecture hall of the building with the address "Renthof 5". This is the main building of the physics department.

If you come up from the old town and stand in front of the building, you have to go all the way to the left, then you will find the entrance to the building which leads to the large lecture hall. You have to go up two flights of stairs. This is marked with "conference site" on the map. The entrance is exactly at the point of the arrow.

Welcome event in the Alte Aula

The welcome event is on Monday, April 8th at 5:30 pm in the Alte Aula. You can get there by taking the elevator mentioned above and turning left down the hill about 80 meters. The official address is "Lahntor 3", but **the access is by the parking area of the church on "Reitgasse 2"**

Conference dinner in the castle

The conference dinner is on Wednesday at 7:30 pm in the "Fürstensaal" of the Marburg Castle (Landgrafenschloss). The exact address is "Schloss 1". Access to Fürstensaal is from the inner courtyard of the castle.

You can also reach the castle walking; it is at the top of the hill.

There are three different ways to get there:

- 1) Via Ritterstraße and then up the stairs (the stairs are indicated by the pink line).
- 2) A slightly longer path leads past the conference venue and is indicated by the green arrows. You also have to go up some stairs at the end.
By the time of the conference dinner, you will know how to find the conference venue. There will be two guides which will guide you from the conference site (Renthof 5) to the castle. One will start at 7 pm and the second one will start at 7:15 pm.



- 3) Then there is another path indicated by the blue bar. However, this leads over really old cobblestones and is therefore very bumpy. There is a risk of stumbling, especially on the way back if the path is not well lit. I would therefore not recommend this route.
